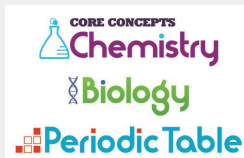

Britannica ImageQuest (K-12th grade)

Over 3 million images for educational, non-commercial use for assignments, projects and lesson plans.



Core Concepts Science (7th-12th grade)

Videos, digital interactive activities and experiments exploring chemistry, biology and the periodic table.



Gale in Context: High School (9th-12th grade)

Reference content such as biographies, primary resources, multimedia, critical essays, news and academic articles.



PebbleGo (K-5th grade)

	Teachingbooks.net (K-12th grade) Collection of interviews with authors and illustrators so students and educators are able to learn directly from them to personalize their connections to the text.
	Teen Health & Wellness (7th-12th grade) Articles on relationship skills, decision-making, growth mindset, PTSD, stress/academic anxiety, social engagement, diversity and family life that support social-emotional learning and physical well-being.
	TrueFLIX (3rd-6th grade) Pairs fictional videos with related non-fiction ebooks about history and science-related topics to support students with literacy skills.
